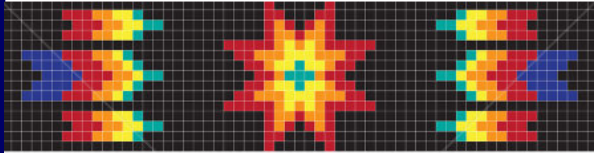


Native American Education will ...

Multicultural Student Services is a resource for students that need academic support or assistance with social-cultural issues. Administrators, counselors, and staff members work together to promote cultural understanding and appreciation for all members of our school district.



Our Services

Native American student eligibility:

Students must be enrolled or have a parent or grandparent enrolled in a federally recognized tribe. Students must also have a valid form on file with our multicultural student services coordinator. Forms can be obtained at each school or counseling office.
